**Curriculum:**

The school curriculum will follow the Noorani Qaida. Students will be evaluated and assigned to the appropriate level. The levels are as follows:

1. Lesson 1 to Lesson 3 (pg. 6-9)
2. Lesson 4 to Lesson 6 (pg. 10-13)
3. Lesson 7 to Lesson 9 (pg. 13-18)
4. Lesson 10 (pg. 18-end)

**Objective:**

Students will develop the ability to read, write, understand, and memorize the Quran according to their placement level. The semester will conclude with a final evaluation of the students' progress.

**School fee:**

The semester fee is \$30 per child, covering the costs of snacks and materials for the duration of the semester.

**Attendance Policy:**

Attendance is strongly encouraged, as it directly impacts the success of your child(ren). Please ensure your child(ren) arrives on time, as unpunctuality will affect both their learning and the progress of the class. We will only allow 3 absences throughout the semester; parents are requested to inform the school in advance if their child is not attending.

The Sunday school will follow the Pullman school district academic calendar. Changes to the school's start and end times are anticipated during Daylight Saving Time in March.

**School Expectations:**

Students are expected to arrive at school on time every Sunday and actively participate in their classes. This includes but is not limited to, bringing the necessary supplies, completing assigned homework, and paying attention during class. Parents should prepare their children to follow the instructions and guidelines provided by the organizers and teachers, as well as to behave respectfully toward the mosque and others.

**Parent involvement:**

Parents are expected the following:

- Be available via phone throughout the duration of the class.
- Provide any necessary information about their child(ren) that organizers and teachers should be aware of (e.g., medical conditions, allergies, etc.).
- Encouraged their child(ren)'s participation and attendance in the school.
- Sign in and sign out their child(ren) at the start and end of the school day.
- Attending the parent-teacher meeting on the first day of the semester (January 7th) and informing the organizers in case of inability to attend.
- Each family is encouraged to contribute to the school by providing and organizing snacks one Sunday in the semester.
